- We want to showcase the women from across the Far South Coast
- We will hang their picture and story in the exhibition for 1 week in July 2018
 - We will cover the cost of printing & mounting the photograph
- The individual person will be given the mounted photo at the end of the exhibition, if a return mailing address is provided
 - The interested person needs to email a digital image for printing
 - All photographs will be printed at 20 cm x 30 cm each to maintain exhibit consistency
 - Individuals must provide a copy of 'Her Can Do Story'.
- Interested person MUST provide digital image & story before 29th June 2018.
